"How can we provide wives for our men, since we have taken an oath by the Lord not to give them any of our daughters?" So they sent 12,000 men, saying, "This is what you are to do. Kill every male and every woman who is not a virgin." They found among the people left living 400 young women who had never slept with a man, and they took them to the camp. And the elders said, "With the women of Benjamin destroyed, how shall we provide wives for the men who are left?" "But look there is an annual festival of the Lord in Shiloh. Go and hide in the vineyards and watch. When the girls of Shiloh come out to join the dancing, then rush from the vineyards and each of you seize a wife from the girls of Shiloh." "So that is what the men of the Lord did. While the girls were dancing, each man caught one and carried her off and raped her as his wife. Then they returned to their inheritance and rebuilt the towns and settled in them." (Judges 21:1-24)

"Are they not finding and dividing the spoils: a girl or two for each man, colorful garments, embroidered garments? So may all your enemies perish, O Lord! But they who love you be like the sun when it rises." (Judges 5:30)

"When a man sells his daughter as a slave, she will not be freed at the end of six years as the men are. If she does not please the man who bought her, he may allow her to be bought back again. But he is not allowed to sell her to foreigners, since he is the one who broke the contract with her. And if the slave girl's owner arranges for her to marry his son..." (Exodus 21:7-11)

"So Sarai (later, Sarah) said to Abram (Abraham the Circumcisor), 'The Lord has kept me from having children. Go and rape my maidservant; perhaps I can build a family through her.' Abram agreed." (Genesis 16:2)

"But these are taken out of context."

Maybe Jehovah (a.k.a. Yahweh) was being sarcastic when he said (via David), "Happy shall be he who smashes the little ones against the stones." (Psalm 137:9) Since this is a brochure, space is limited. Therefore, the location of each passage is stated for easy reference so that the reader may look it up. * As a simple but commonly used scare-tactic, Christians adopted the Roman God Lucifer, who was God of the Morning Star or "light bearer." Later, to incite the mass torturing of Pagans, the God Pan was used to personify evil. Pan represents the masculine side of natural forces and is portrayed as half human-male and half deer; hence the horns. Goddesses, such as Artemis (Acts 19:23), were considered but the church felt that would assign power to femininity. There are several biblical references to Jehovah being the devil. "I form the light and create darkness, I bring peace and create evil. I, the Lord, do all these things." (Isaiah 45:7) Renewed interest in biblical ceremonies helped spark the impetus during the 1980s for Christian youth to popularize Christian Devil Worship - a mainly theatrical activity promoted by male rock and roll bands. **The ceremonies performed by Christian Devil Worshipers can be found in the bible in Leviticus 1 through 9, referred to as "Guidelines for Offerings to God."**

"Before your eyes I will take your wives and give them to your neighbor and he will rape them in broad daylight. You sinned in secret, but I will do this in the presence of all with the sun looking down."

(2 Samuel 12:11)

"The blueness of a wound cleanseth away evil; so do stripes on the inward parts of the belly. Blows and wounds cleanse away evil, and beatings purge the inmost being."

(Proverbs 20:30)

"Then Moses said to them, 'This is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says: "Each man strap a sword to his side. Go back and forth through the camp from one end to the other, each killing his brother and friend and neighbor.'" The people did as Moses commanded, and that day three thousand of the people died. Then Moses said, "You have been set apart to the Lord today, for you were against your own sons and brothers, and he has blessed you this day." (Exodus 32:27)

Please note: With the exception of Genesis, all passages appear after the now quite humorous “Thou shalt not kill” - one of ten commandments that appears in the Egyptian Book of the Dead (4100 B.C.E.) before Moses spent weeks carving them on Mount Sinai.

Christian women should be required to wear burqas

“If a woman does not cover her head, she should have her hair cut off. A man ought not to cover his head since he is the image and glory of God. Neither was man created for woman, but woman for man. For this reason, and because of the angles, she should have a sign of authority on her head.” “Long hair is given to her as a covering.” (I Corinthians 11:6-10, 15) Christian women are still required to cover their heads at Catholic points of interest, such as when touring St. Peter’s basilica in Rome.

You shall serve your husband, and he shall rule over you.’” (Genesis 3:16) There are currently four states with Christian movements to ban pain medication for mothers - GA, KA, AL, and MS. These groups maintain that since it was their god’s intent for women to suffer during childbirth as testimony of his disdain for women; women should not be denied his pain.

Did you know? The Pagan “Christmas” Tree is forbidden

“Thus says the Lord, ‘Do not learn the way of the Pagan nations, or be dismayed by signs in the sky, though the nations are terrified by them. But if she gives birth to a daughter, then she shall be unclean two weeks, as in her isolation, and she shall continue in the blood of her purifying threescore and six days. Then she must wait sixty-six days to be purified from her bleeding. When the days of her purification for a son or daughter are over, she is to bring the priest a year-old lamb and a young pigeon for a sin offering. In this way the priest shall forgive her and she will be clean.’” (Leviticus 12:2-8)

A bride who is not a virgin shall receive death penalty

“If no proof of the girl’s virginity can be found (no cloth with vaginal blood provided by her father) she shall be brought to the door of her father’s house, there the men of her town shall stone her to death. You must purge the evil from among you.” (Deuteronomy 22:13-21)

Rape victim must marry the rapist

“If a man happens to meet a virgin who is not pledged to be married and rapes her, he shall pay the girl’s father fifty shekels of silver. He must marry the girl for he has violated her. They may never divorce.” (Deuteronomy 22:28)

“If a man seduces a virgin who is not pledged to be married and rapes her, he must pay the bride-price, and she shall be his wife.” (Exodus 22:16)

Gang Rape

(A father offers his daughter to a mob to protect a male guest)

“Behold, here is my virgin daughter, and his concubine; I will them bring out now. Humble them, and do with them what seems good to you: but to this man do not do so vile a thing.’ But the men would not hearken to him: so the man took her and brought her to them; and they raped her, and abused her all the night until the morning, and when the day began to spring, they let her go.

“There she lay in the doorway of the house, with her hands on the threshold. He said to her “Get up; Let us go.” But there was no answer. Then the man put her on his donkey and set out for home. When he reached home he took a knife and cut her limb by limb.” (Judges 19:23-29)

God sets his followers’ children on fire

“Fire came out of the presence of the Lord and consumed them, and they died before the Lord. And to Aaron (the boys’ father) and his remaining sons he said, ‘Do not let your hair become unkempt, and do not tear your clothes, or you will feel the fire of the Lord who will be angry with you and all of the community. But your relatives may mourn for those the Lord has destroyed by fire.’” (Leviticus 10:2)

“...they shall fall by the sword: their infants shall be dashed in pieces, and their pregnant women shall be ripped open.” (Hosea 13:16)

Girls are war booty

Moses: “And kill every woman who has slept with a man, but save for yourselves every girl who has never slept with a man.” (Numbers 31:17-18)

“Behold, I am against you,’ says the Lord of hosts, ‘I will lift up your skirts over your face, and I will let nations look on your nakedness and kingdoms on your shame. I will pelt you with filth.” (Nahum 3:5)

“..the Lord will smite with a scab the heads of the daughters of Zion, and the Lord will lay bare their secret parts.” (Isaiah 3:17)

“Behold the day of the Lord is coming, when the spoil taken from you will be divided in the midst of you. For I will gather the nations against Jerusalem to battle, and the city shall be taken and the houses plundered and the women raped...” (Zechariah 14:1)

“The angel said, ‘Look what is appearing.’ He then added, ‘This is the curse that goes over the earth.’ He then lifted the cover of the basket and in the basket sat a woman. The angel said, ‘This is wickedness,’ and he pushed her back into the basket and covered her.” (Zechariah 5:5)

“The wise will be put to shame; they will be dismayed and trapped. They have rejected the word of the Lord, and what wisdom is in them? Therefore I will give their wives to other men.” (Jeremiah 8:9-10)

“It is not well for a man to marry a woman. But since there is so much immorality, ...” (1 Corinthians 7:1)

“If a man lies with a woman during her monthly period and has sexual relations with her, he has exposed the Source of her flow, and she also has uncovered it. Both of them must be cut off from their people.” (Leviticus 20:18)

“But some of these are quotes from the old testament.” Yes, as is the Creation story, Noah’s Ark, and the Ten Commandments. In fact, these are in the first two books of the Old Testament. It is the Old Testament, which makes up over three-fourths of the bible, that Christian groups demand be taught in public schools. “Do not approach a woman during the uncleanness of her monthly period. It is better to not look at her.” (Leviticus 18:19)

“When you march up to attack a city, make its people an offer of peace. If they accept and open their gates, all the people in it shall be subject to forced labor and shall work for you. If they refuse to make peace and fight back, lay siege to that city. When the Lord your God delivers it into your hand, put to the sword all the men in it. As for the women, the children, the livestock and everything else in the city, you may take these as plunder for yourselves. And you may use the plunder the Lord your God gives you. This is how you are to treat all the cities that are at a distance from you.” (Deuteronomy 20:10)

“He is to bring two young doves or pigeons to the priest, who shall first offer the one for the sin offering. He is to wring its head from its neck, not severing it completely, and is to sprinkle some of the blood against the side of the altar; the rest of the blood must be drained out at the base of the altar.” (Leviticus 5:8)
